

GOOD THUNDER PUBLIC HEARING  
Minutes of the Public Hearing  
May 11, 2026

Mayor Robert Anderson called the Public Hearing to order at 6:30pm at City Hall at 130 S Ewing Street in Good Thunder, MN 56037. Councilors Scott Stoltzman, Amy Klammer and Jim Day were present. Councilor Jon Brude was absent. Sue Petty, City Clerk-Treasurer, was present. Eli Depuydt, City Maintenance Supervisor, and Brian Severns were absent.

The pledge was recited, immediately followed by a moment of silence.

**Public Hearing:** The public hearing for Small City Development Grant & Other Funding Sources Infrastructure Improvements Project was opened. Mark Klema presented to council the needs, alternatives considered, recommended alternative, potential project cost, funding sources- PFA, RD, SCDP, and proposed project schedule. The water treatment plant and Well 1 and Well 2 are Project 1, S. Halladay St water main/ sanitary sewer/storm sewer improvements are project 2. Replacement of lead service lines will also be included. Bollig will submit an application for PFA funding to replace the lead service lines. The Water treatment construction could begin later this fall, but most likely in 2027. Representatives from Lyra Township asked about the amount of water running into the box culvert on Hubble Lane from the proposed storm sewer reconstruction. Mark assured them there is only an increase in .34 acre of impervious surface therefore there would be minimal increase. A retention pond is not required as the increase in impervious surface is less than 1 acre. It was agreed there would be a meeting at the box culvert in question that will include Mark Klema, representatives from Lyra Township, Eli and Mayor Anderson. The cost breakdown of the project is as follows:

Drinking Water Source & Treatment: \$7,570,000  
Drinking Water Distribution: \$1,150,000  
Sanitary/Storm Sewer: \$2,155,000  
Total cost: \$10,875,000

No more discussion was had. Mayor Anderson called for a motion to close the Public Hearing; Councilor Day made a motion to close the Public Hearing, Councilor Stoltzman seconded; motion carried. Public Hearing close at 7:20pm
